LOCATION: 56 miles south-east of Prince George, 15 miles south of Dome Creek Station on the CNR.

ACCESS: By helicopter from Prince George or 8 miles from the logging road running south from Dome Creek Station.


OWNERSHIP: Joe Lorsa and Associates of Smithers

DESCRIPTION: Regionally the showings are within a generally flat-lying sequence of Lower Cambrian limestone, quartzite, and related sedimentary rocks. Locally, the rocks have been tightly folded with the axes generally striking east-west. Chalcopyrite, specularite, quartz, calcite, and possibly dolomite have been introduced along fractures within the fold axes. Unfortunately, the mineralized fractures are too widely spaced. Some replacement was noted near fracture intersections. Exposure is relatively good since the showings are above timber line.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The property does not warrant further consideration.
