ABSTRACT

CHUCHI LAKE PROPERTY, B.C.

This silver-lead-zinc prospect is located 120 miles N.W. of Prince George, B.C. and was discovered late in the fall of 1964.

The 8 original claims under option for \$100,000 were surrounded by 28 claims by staking.

Three exposures in altered volcanics and sediments have been found over a 700 ft. length.

First sampling on the E zone gave 3.77% Zn and 1.63% Pb over a true width of 26 ft. across a limey brecciated zone. Recent sampling in adjacent volcanics which were not previously thought minerlaised showed 2.96% Zn and 1.12% Pb over 12 ft. This increases the tonnage potential of the area.

Barium is present, about 4-5% and 0.1% Cadmium.

Crash geological and geophysical programs were terminated by the freeze-up.

Most of the claims area is covered by swamp and glacial debris.

Continued work is planned for early May.
