We have examined the data available on your Wigwam Property and enjoyed a tour of the ground accompanied by Mr. Tough. We are of the opinion that the geology is much more complex than may at first site be apparent and I suggest that a simple down dip continuity of ore bands is most unlikely. With the grades available it would be a tough nut to crack both from an exploration and mining standpoint and we would not be interested in taking up an option at this stage. It is a great pity that drill log and assay data from the early work are not available as this would allow a much more exact assessment of the potential and problems. If these do become available we would be interested to reassess the property.

I will return copies of reports and maps to Mr. Tough as requested.

We thank you for giving Cyprus the opportunity to examine the property and I hope that other opportunities for joint ventures may arise.
