PLUTUS MINES, LIKELY, B.C.

I inspected this property on August 19th accompanied by Vic Bjorkman, the consultant, Henry Offers and Nels Pentecost, director and president respectively.

Briefly my impressions are:

- 1. The structure is strong.
- 2. There is an excellent change of grades improving underground.
- Driving the adit followed by drifting on the vein is the best procedure.
- 4. They have \$120,000 in the treasury now, most or all supplied by stock sold without commission to net the treasury 50¢ a share.
- 5. The grade is much lower than indicated by assays reported to me, obviously grab samples.
- 6. Vic Bjorkman's assays are systematically taken,
- 7. I had, or have, an option to take 100,000 shares at 50¢, subject to inspection of the property.

PLUTUS MINES LTD. (N.P.L.) NEAR LIKELY, CARIBOO DISTRICT BRITISH COLUMBIA

SUMMARY

This report is made for Plutus Mines Ltd. at the request of Mr. Nelson Pentecost, President.

The purpose is to evaluate mineral showings on a 51 claim group of mining claims 7 miles north east of Likely, B.C. and to present recommendations for further exploration if warranted.

The claims lie on the Westerly flank of a mountain bordering Black Bear Creek on the northerly bank.

The underlying rocks are schists of the Cariboo Group as mapped by the Geological Survey of Canada. The silver-lead mineralization is found in quartz filled fracture veins dipping NE into the mountain and striking NW - SE. Some degree of mineral localization is found to be caused by faults crossing the vein structures.

Sampling gives average grade of mineralization of 5.8 oz. of silver per ton and 2.27% lead per ton for a gross value of \$13.00 ton. Average width of sample taken was 5' but widths from 1 foot to 11 feet were encountered. It is believed that some loss of mineral in the outcrop may be due to leaching and that at depth values should be less erratic. Silver-lead ratios are well established at slightly greater than 2 oz. silver to 1% of lead.

Because of the nature of the host rock and the dip into the mountain of the vein system diamond drilling is not considered to be the best method for further exploration. A crosscut adit and drifting on the vein is recommended with some additional buildozer stripping. Total cost of the recommended program is estimated at \$85,000.00
