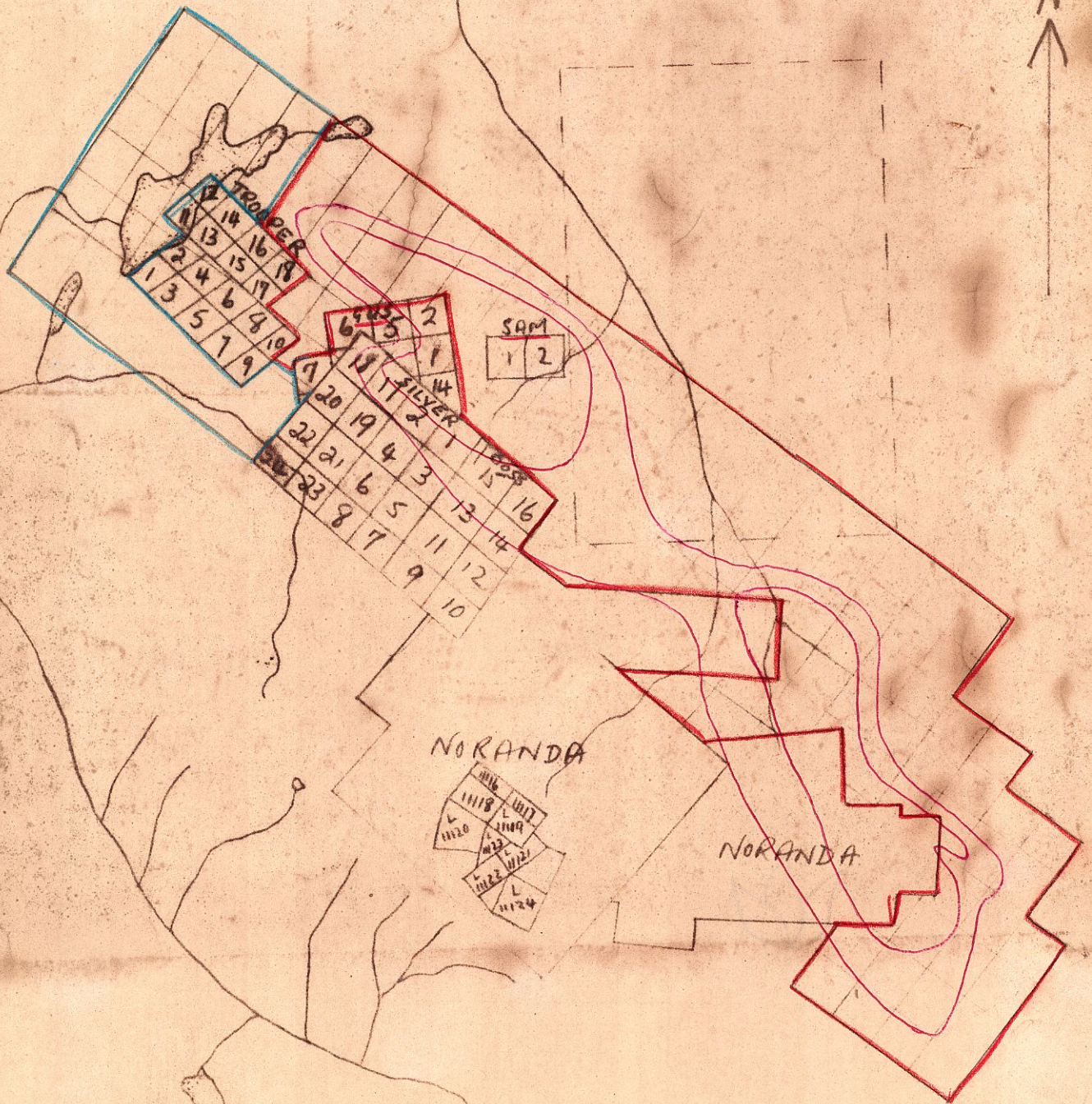

Subject: re AREA "J" CLAIM SITUATION

The attached sketch shows the claims presently in good standing in our area "J", as well as an outline of the area which we are attempting to stake. The claim data is up to date as of March 5th according to the records in the Quesnel office of the B.C. Government.

As you will see, there are two new blocks of claims in this area of which we did not have previous knowledge. These are the Trooper claims 1 - 18 and the Silver Boss claims 1 - 24. Complete data for these claims presently in good standing are as follows:
