I enclose for your information the following reports and maps pertaining to our Area "J".

- Progress Report to July 31st re Linecutting from Alrae Engineering.
- 2. Copy of a letter from William P. McGill & Associates Ltd., reporting on the progress of work by that Company to late July, and also some comments with regard to Area "G". Gide gingle
- 3. Copy of the plan received from Alrae showing the control lines cut by them with tie-ins to some of the claims.

Some difficulty is being encountered in locating all of the claims, however McGill have undertaken to clear this up before completing the work there. It is apparent that there is some open ground between our claims and the Noranda claims, and between our claims and some of the Silver Boss claims. I have instructed McGill's to stake these open areas. It is also apparent from this work that a greater part of the ground we staked than we had originally thought is, in fact, invalid, due to the over-staking on already existing claims. The Gus is as shown on the Alrae map which is quite a way north and where we originally thought. Some additional claims have been added earlier this summer also to the original Silver Boss group.

An article from the "Williams Lake Tribune" attached to the Alrae Progress Report is of interest. As far as I can find out, these people are a group of local private individuals

and, if necessary, we could probably come to some arrangement with them should the results of our work show that their ground is of interest to us.

I expect to receive the Barringer Geochemical Report on this area in the near future.
