
Dear Wilf:

As you are aware, a number of the claims which we staked in the Swift Lake area in connection with our work on your Top prospect remained registered in the name of Bolivar Mining Corporation Ltd. even though the option agreement was cancelled earlier this year. In order to clean up some of the technicalities and because Cyprus will be collapsing its subsidiary, Bolivar Mining Corporation Ltd., we have recently registered with the B. C. Department of Mines, Bills of Sale transferring to you 198 claims which remain in good standing. Enclosed herewith please find a copy of the Bill of Sale and of the official receipt in the amount of \$990.00 pertaining to this transfer.

Since that date we have had six other addresses, so finding Cyprus Mines Corporation at 630 Fifth Avenue represents quite a bit of detective work by the much maligned Post Office.


Enclosed are copies of correspondence that reached Mr. Hansen's office today.
