

Stump Lake, Merritt Area

We have today received from Mr. A. W. McGuire of Merritt, a prospect submission at Stump Lake. The attached samples are from this prospect. From a brief inspection, the mineralization would appear to be chalcopyrite and tetrahedrite in an acid intrusive. McGuire claims to have this material over an area at least 1,500 feet by 800 feet, and they have six trenches on the property. His best assays from picked samples run about 6 ozs. of silver and over 2% copper. The general location of the prospect is shown on the accompanying sketch. accessible from the paved highway.

Although there is an old gold mine located on the east side of Stump Lake, McGuire claims this is a new prospect. He also claims they have obtained low grade values from this material. From the information provided us so far, this would appear to be a good open pit possibility if it will grade at all.

I have arranged to make a field examination with McGuire next Wednesday, October 9th.


