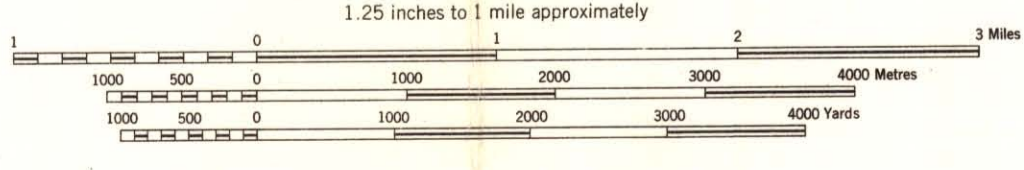

 1.25 inches to 1 mile approximately

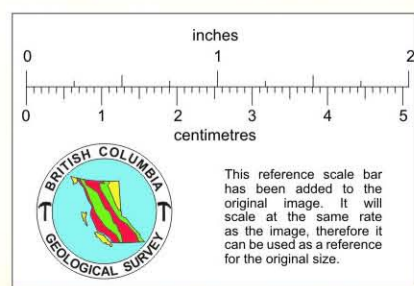


CONTOUR INTERVAL 100 FEET
