SUMMARY

A Cretaceous (?) stock intrudes argillaceous rocks. Intrusive berars molybdenite along fracture planes. Samples of intrusive and mineralized collar rocks gave low assay values.

CONCLUSIONS

Mineralization is not extensive enough to be of interest to us at the present time.

RECOMMENDATIONS

No further work to be done.

INTRODUCTION

The property was submitted to Atlas by A. Brewer in January 1970. Examination of the property took place in early June, 1970. Four hours were spent on the property but all areas of known mineralization were seen.

LOCATION

The property is located south of Westwold, B.C. at approximately $50^{\circ}25$ 'N lat., and $119^{\circ}45$ 'W long.

ACCESS

From Westwold by 4-wheel-drive vehicle - a distance of 7 miles.

PROPERTY AND OWNERSHIP

The Claims are jointly held by Brewer, Brewer and Jourdain of Vernon B.C.

TOPOGRAPHY

Mountainous.

HISTORY OF THE OCCURRENCE

Has been held by present vendors for 4 years. Has been drilled on two occasions; first by Bralorne Pioneer and second by an individual. Both dropped their option.

GENERAL GEOLOGY

Cretaceous granite (porphyritic) intrudes argillaceous sedimentary rocks (Cache Creek). Contact zones are hornfelsed. Tertiary volcanics cap the upper parts of the intrusion; only the western flank is exposed.

MINERALIZATION


Molybdenite is distributed along fractures in the granite. Not well fractured in general and very little introduced quartz or alteration. Hornfels outcrop north of Adelphi Creek carries small amount of molybdenite and traces of chalcopyrite. (see assays No. 1137 and 1138).

COMMENTS

The intrusive does not show favourable signs for mineralization of ore grade. Molybdenite where present is somewhat coarsegrained. Copy of report by Paul Lafleur is appended. Tungsten mineralization is not substantiated by assays.
