
I hope you are in good health and enjoying the summer weather, but go easy on the hills.

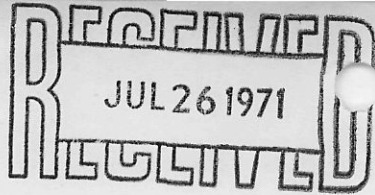

We have a couple of copper properties here, besides the Nicholson Creek copper molybdenum show, which I would like to bring to your attention, and could be of interest to your company.

Both copper properties are close to transportation and at low elevations.  
2,100' FT

The Copper Bluff property, located on Chimelment Creek. U.S.K. area elevation 2,100' FT. Six claims held by location 5 crown grants width 40' FT. Average grade 1.77 copper & 0.3 silver.

Traced for 900' FT by open cuts to fault, we have now located continuation of zone beyond fault which I feel sure will add at least 300 to 400' FT more to length of ore zone, which is in contact to quartz albite dyke. There are other copper shows in the property. The above the only one work done on.

The other copper property Galeonda. Was under option to Shasta Mines and Oils. The company got into difficulties, and the property was sold, for debt. We bought it back, as I was the original owner. Shasta did considerable work, also soil sampling and had an I.P. run which shows two large anomaly areas also some diamond drilling. There are a number of showings both high grade and medium. There is a camp on the property also a good cut road from highway to camp. There are 40 claims on this property.

We hope to have the four claims on the Nicholson Creek property which was in contention cleared up by the end of July.

I might state we have clear title to the claims of both copper properties and all the claims are in good standing.
