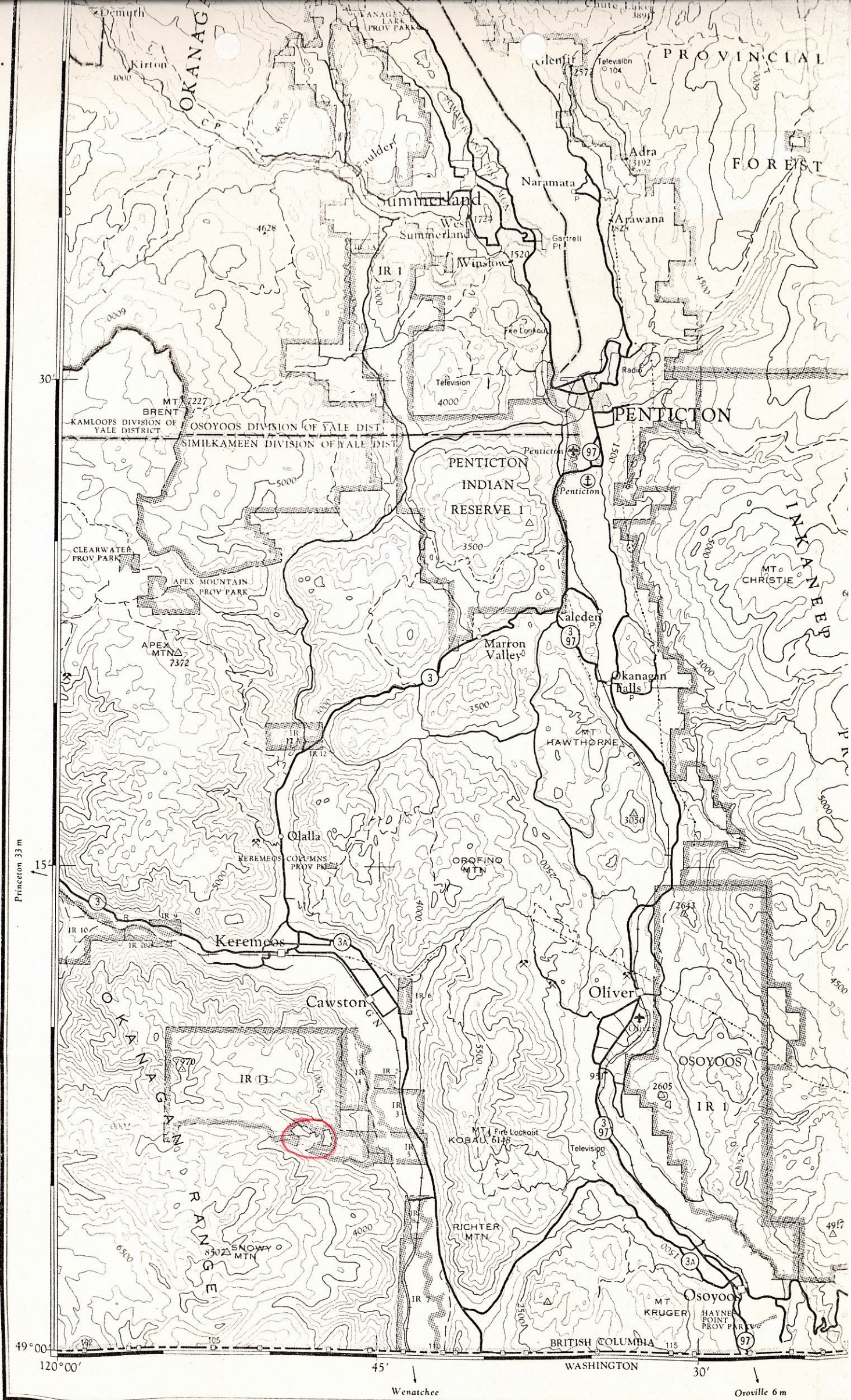

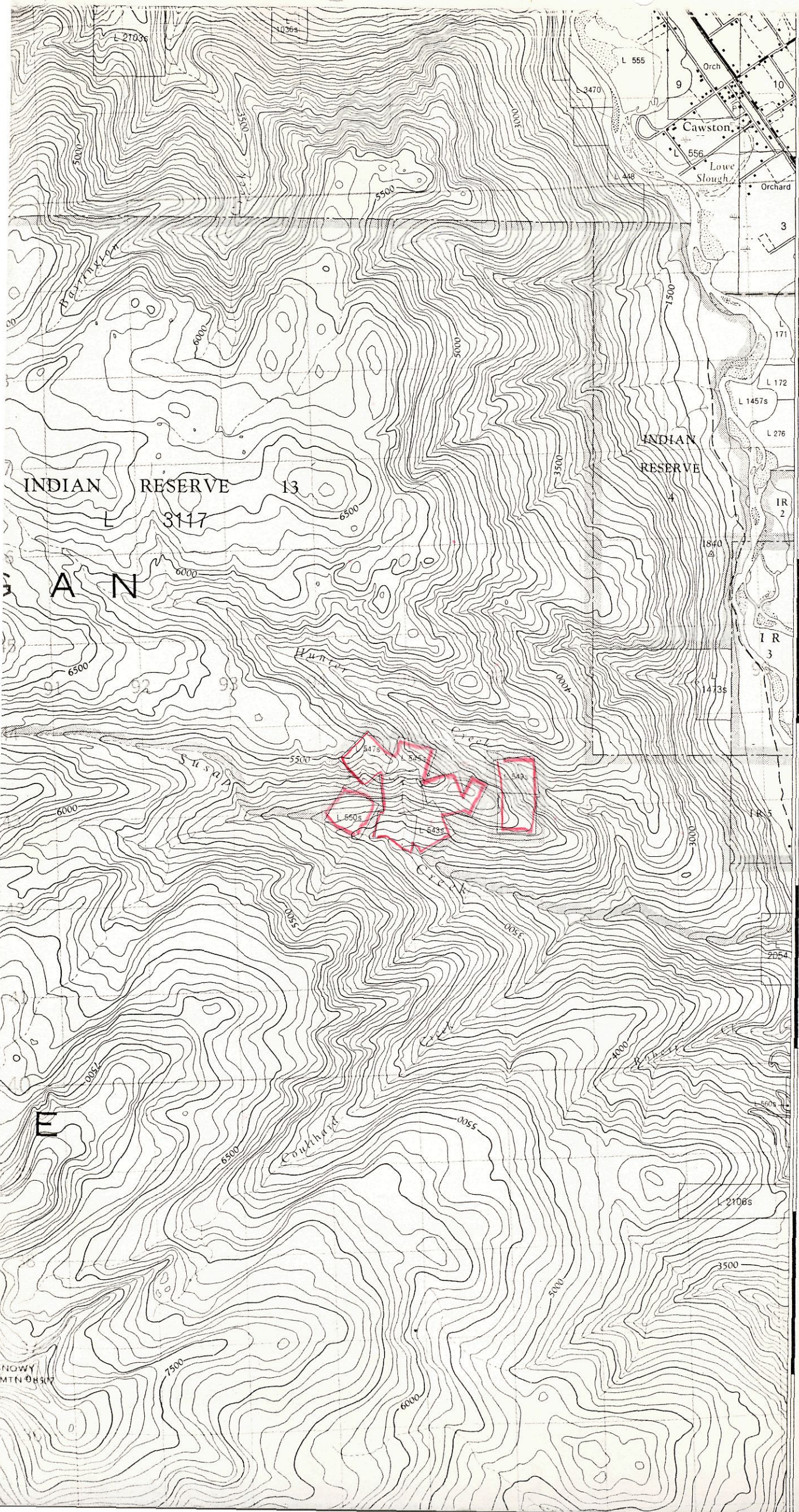


RELIABILITY DIAGRAM - CROQUIS D'EXACTITUDE

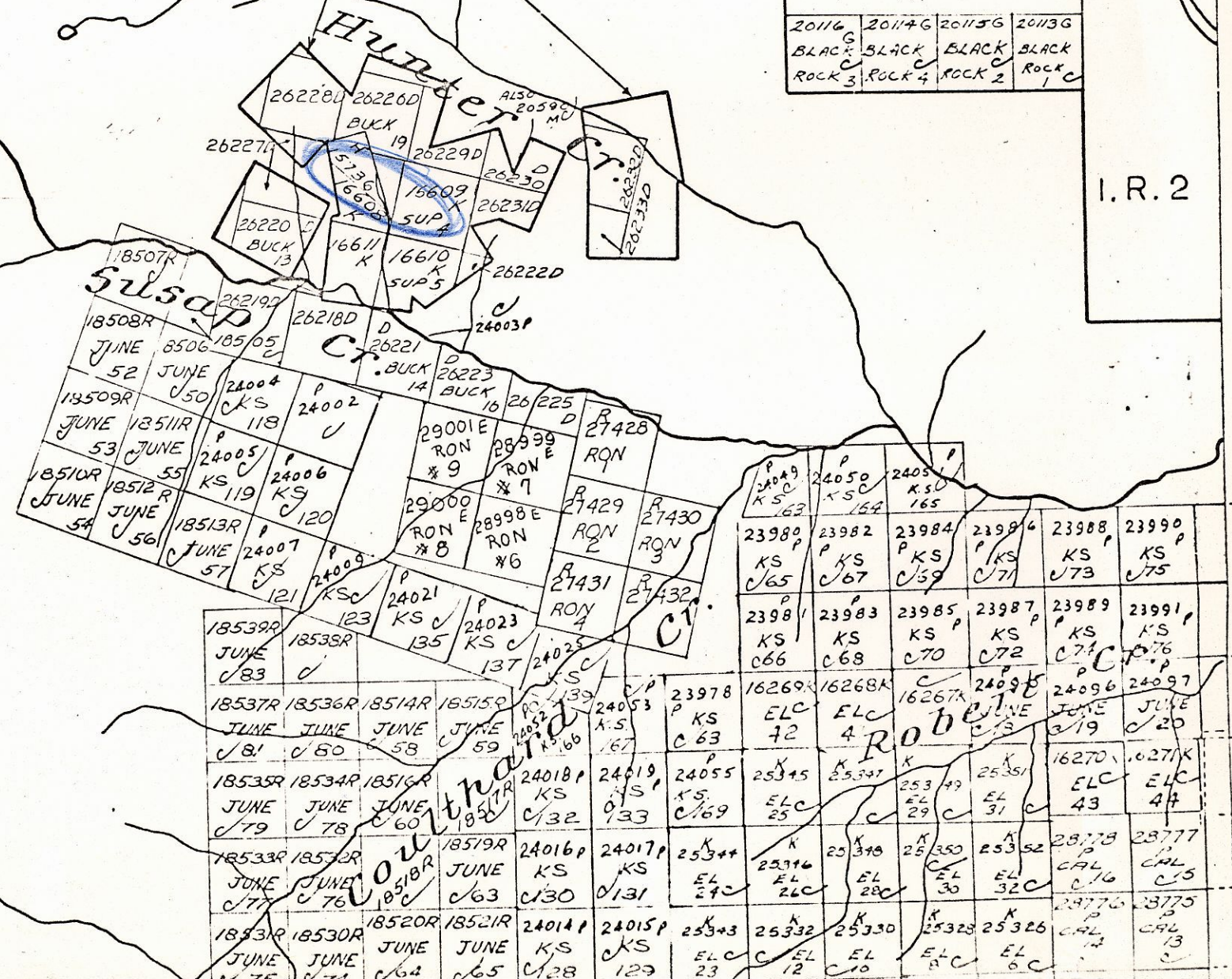

Dear Mr. Murdoch:

Our company property examination reports are considered confidential and I am, therefore, not able to send you a copy of Will's report on your copper property. I am returning your report and maps with this letter.

We are definitely not interested in your Mayo silver claims at this time. As far as the Osoyoos claims are concerned, we feel that the property has excellent merit but our exploration budget for the coming season is heavily committed to do work in the Yukon and it is unlikely, therefore, that the company will have enough funds available to do any kind of exploration work in B.C. As well, we feel that the deal you want on the property is rather rigorous. In any case, I will let you know when we arrive at a final decision.
