Dear Harry,

As you can see from the enclosed assay results, the two breccia samples near NC3 and ND6 respectively contain more than enough ppm of Pb/Zn to explain the soil anomalies. The rock assay was a bit disappointing, and the silver value at 17.8 gm per ton, or just over half an ounce, is not likely to generate too much interest.

While I would not dispute your general thesis that the breccia would make a good host for mineralization, it would seem that it isn't good enough, at least where we can get a close look at it. Some surface leaching may have taken place but I would not expect this to be too effective.

In better times, we might have been tempted to test the strike extent of the dolomite contact with further geochem and perhaps I.P., but as things stand, and with the low silver ratio's implied, I don't think it is a prime prospect at this time.

Many thanks for the tour which I thoroughly enjoyed, and I hope to meet you again sometime.
