Dear Sirs:

On March the 18th, I sent you a proposal concerning a jointly financed program to collect certain public information on mineral deposits in British Columbia and the Yukon Territory. So far I have had sixteen replies; thirty-five organizations received the proposal. Of these, thirteen are favourable, two are definitely not interested and one is undecided.

Two organizations have expressed interest in doing the work. B.C. Research Council and Earl Dodson of MacDonal Consultants. Dodson has been involved in a similar project and is going to try to come up with an additional cost estimate.

I suggest representatives of the organizations which have expressed interest have a meeting on Tuesday, April 28th, at the Engineers Club, to discuss details and consider modifications of the proposal which have been suggested. I will be contacting you towards the end of next week to set up the time for this meeting. If you have not replied to the original letter, I would appreciate it if you would let me know as soon as possible, so that if you are interested, you may be included in further discussions.



If you would be interested in participating, please let me know. If the general response is favourable, I will obtain a firm estimate of costs, and let you know.

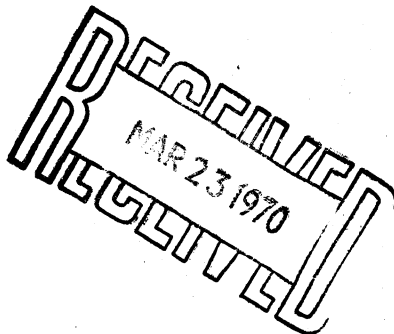
Any additional comments you may have on this proposal would be welcome.

A PROPOSAL FOR ASSEMBLING SOME BASIC DATA ON THE MINERAL DEPOSITS OF BRITISH COLUMBIA AND THE YUKON

One of the first steps in exploration is to compile data on mineral deposits in the area of interest. Such work would be greatly facilitated if certain basic information, such as the location of deposits, was available. What follows is a proposal to obtain this data on a cost-sharing basis.

PURPOSE: To record the following information on all mineral deposits and showings which are described in G.S.C. publications and British Columbia Minister of Mines Annual Reports:

1. Location (To be plotted on mylar overlays of 1:250,000 topo maps).
2. Major commodities)To be listed on
3. Property name(s))sheets to accompany
4. References to geologic data and simple rating of the)the location map:
quality and quantity of geologic data in the reference)see enclosed sample.

Space would be left on the list sheets for individual participants to add references to their own files.

METHOD: The data would be collected by relatively untrained personnel supervised perhaps by the B.C. Research Council or some independent service organization. The initial cost would be shared by the participants; revenue from subsequent sales of the file could be put into a fund to keep the file up to date, and perhaps expand the data base to incorporate other public information (e.g. references to assessment reports, specific non-geologic data such as production, etc.). Results would be distributed as copies of the data sheets, and prints of the topo map mylar overlays.

COST: The cost is estimated to be in the order of \$10-20,000. There are probably 20 organizations which would be interested in participating, making the cost per individual less than \$1000.

TIMING: We would like to see the project finished as quickly as possible-hopefully by the end of the summer.
