This letter is in reference to telephone conversations between the Assistant Mining Recorder and myself regarding assessment work due on claims in the Kinskuch Lake area of the Skeena Mining Division.

The following description of additional staking should be included within the agreement:

The option agreement is contingent upon the success of Kerr Addison Mines to acquire by staking prior to June 1st, 1970 the open ground within the group of mineral claims plus adjacent ground deemed necessary to protect the claim group. From given information regarding previous staking, the following mineral claims are required:

Ted 1 M.C. adjoins Kinskuch 5 and 7 on the north, Jean M.C. (plus Ted Fraction to be staked) on the west, and open ground on the east and south boundary.

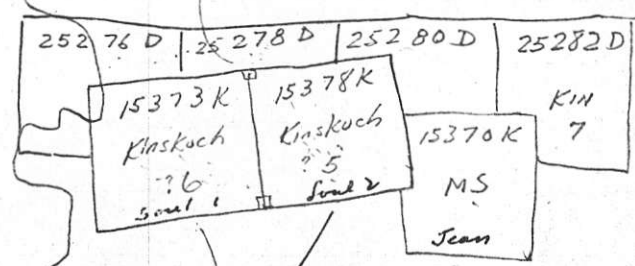
