As agreed, I have made a further redraft of the agreement and have sent four (4) copies thereof, in form suitable for execution, to our client. I had some difficulty in redrafting clause 2, particularly with reference to the contributions to be made

by your client to the amounts expended in the various years. The clause in the enclosed draft contains my latest thoughts on the matter, but I should be very glad to have your comments on it. As a result of the changes in clause 2, I had to make equivalent changes in clause 7.

You will note that I have also made the agreed changes in clause 5 (a) so that the price on any offer made by Asbestos to Prospectors Airways will be payable within 90 days after the acceptance of such offer by Prospectors Airways and so that the delay for acceptance of any such offer by Prospectors Airways is increased from 30 days to 180 days. The only other changes are those suggested in the memorandum sent to me with your letter.
