



by your client to the amounts expended in the various years. The clause in the enclosed draft contains my latest thoughts on the matter, but I should be very glad to have your comments on it. As a result of the changes in clause 2, I had to make equivalent changes in clause 7.

You will note that I have also made the agreed changes in clause 5 (a) so that the price on any offer made by Asbestos to Prospectors Airways will be payable within 90 days after the acceptance of such offer by Prospectors Airways and so that the delay for acceptance of any such offer by Prospectors Airways is increased from 30 days to 180 days. The only other changes are those suggested in the memorandum sent to me with your letter.

According to the agreement with Henry Taken Jack the transfers from Taken Jack in favor of P.A. were to be deposited in escrow with the Canadian Bank of Commerce at Whitehorse.

Actually the claims were transferred to E.O. Chisholm (August 17th 1955) and we have transfers on file from E.O. Chisholm to P.A., which cannot be registered until P.A. takes out a Miner's license in B.C.

I do not know what has been placed in escrow with the Bank at Whitehorse (if anything) and I suggest that Ivor Mast contacts the Bank to find this out.

~~Since~~ P.A. has decided for the time being not to take out a B.C. license; If the option should be fully exercised, then the claims could be directly transferred to the new company to be formed and another transfer from Chisholm to the new company would be required.

I suggest that we obtain a blank transfer from E. O. Chisholm, which could be used for transfer to the new company if, as and when formed. (or to transfer the claims back to Henry Taken Jack)

In case the option is not exercised, then the

Taken Claims would have to be ^{re-}transferred back to H. Taken Jack and it would therefore

be advisable that we obtain now a transfer from E. O. Chisholm to Henry Taken Jack. not made out!

This could be placed in escrow with the Bank with instructions to hand these transfer over to H. Taken Jack in case we do not make the payments provided ^{for} in the option agreement.

We decided to keep the blank transfer here to be used either for transfer to the new Co or to H. Taken Jack

In view of our obligations towards the Asbestos Corporation I believe it is important that the transfer situation should be straightened out as suggested
