Dear Charlie:

Further to our telephone conversation of this morning, we have considered your suggestion that we take advantage of the remainder of the present field season to proceed with a surface appraisal of the Taku Asbestos claims.

In view of the rather inaccessible nature of this ground, Peter Riordon maintains that it would probably take ten days to two weeks to establish a camp near the showing. Even assuming that the ground will be free of snow until mid October, the weather conditions during the remaining two weeks will probably be sufficiently adverse to considerably hamper the work of trenching and mapping.

It seems doubtful whether anything useful would be accomplished under the circumstances. On the other hand, it is agreed that further ground should be staked to the north and south of the existing block in order to avoid being too hemmed in. Presumably Ted Chisholm could arrange to have this staking done under the supervision of one of the Taku brothers.

I hope the above views will meet with your concurrence, in which case we will be prepared to make an early start on the work in the spring of 1956.
