SEDEX Exploration - Ecstall Mining Land Tenure-Kwadacha Claims

To the north of the Cirque area Ecstall Mining holds three claim blocks staked within the Kwadacha Recreation Area. The claims are as follows:

These are one post claims staked in accordance with regulation for claims in recreation areas; each claim consists of 16 units. Each of Ecstall's claim groups consists of two claims totalling 32 units. All of these claims come due in 1992 and will require \$19,200 of work (\$6400 per claim group).

The only significant showing on any of these claims is the Kwadacha Barite Deposit located on the Georges Peak Claim Group. Part of one of these claims, CV 8090, extends into the Kwadacha Wilderness Park, this is a Class A Park. This is a very interesting showing but its location within the Recreation Area and Wilderness Park precludes any potential option of these claims. When a program is mobilized into the Gataga Camp the barite showing should definitely be visited.

None of the Kwadacha claims should presently be considered for acquisition.
