Subject New Claim Groups - Kamloops Area, B.C. (92 - I - 16) Date November 29th, 1965.

We have acquired the following claim groups as a result of the aeromagnetic release of November 23rd, 1965:

The Orchard Lake Group is located 23 miles northeast of Kamloops and was staked on a thumb-print anomaly with an intensity of 300 gammas. The claims have been designated Orchard 1-9 M.C.'s, and the group has been assigned code BC-13.

The Vinsulla Group is located 19 miles north of Kamloops on Highway No. 5 and on the Canadian National Railway. The centre of the anomaly is about 200 feet east of the road and railway track. This group was staked on a 1,700 gamma anomaly at the contact between granites and Cache Creek greenstones. There could also be some limestone at the contact. The name on the claim tags is Vin 1-9 M.C.'s, and this group has been assigned code BC-14.

The claims will be recorded here within the next few days, and all of the necessary forms will be sent to Ted Jacka complete with open transfers.

The staking was done by Clyde Smith and Bruce Bannister, and on their way back from the Orchard Lake Group they encountered a mining man by the name of Bob Beaton who expressed some dismay that he had not got to the Orchard Lake anomaly before we did.

Both groups are highly accessible and will be relatively inexpensive to investigate.
