# Drilling starts on Arizona bet for Metoil Res. 820412

Metoil Resources says a 2-phase drill program has been launched at the former-producing Pilgrim gold mine in Arizona, which Metoil holds in a joint venture with Galli Exploration Associates, of Reno, Nev.

The property consists of five patented and 90 additional claims staked along the exposed length of a structure 1.5 miles long and 400 ft. wide.

Galli is operator on the project. Metoil Vice-President Grant Howes tells The Northern Miner the first phase of the drill program will consist of 4,800 ft. of shallow reverse circulation drilling to prove up open pit potential. "The deposit is amenable to heap leaching," he said.

Depending on results from this initial work, further work will consist of several deep holes and additional shallow drilling, the Metoil executive said.

The company says there are a series of veins over a 2,000-ft. width, with fractures and shears in between, some of high grade. Reserves are estimated at 100,000 tons grading 0.5 oz. gold per ton.

To finance the current drilling, Metoil carried through a private placement of \$100,000, 80% of which, Mr. Howes said, was taken down by company directors and employees.

Metoil is listed on the Vancouver and Alberta stock exchanges, and currently trades in the 60¢-per-share range.

## Gold-bearing zone outlined by Harlin

A gold-bearing shear zone has been outlined from mapping and sampling on the Bonanza gold prospect of Harlin Resources, just west of Lillooet, B.C., the company reports.

President Anthony Agostino says the zone has been traced on surface and for more than 50 ft. down an incline, and averaged 4-5 ft. in thickness.

Sampling included a width of 3 ft. at a grade of 0.43 oz. gold per ton, 4 ft. at 1.612 oz., and another 4 ft. at 0.186 oz. gold per ton, Mr. Agostino said.

He said the gold appears to be associated with black argillite and arsenopyrite mineralization, with numerous quartz lenses.

A drill program is scheduled to follow a detailed evaluation of results to date.
