I have received the following information concerning a new discovery made by Highland-Bell Limited in Northwestern British Columbia.

Originally it was thought that the chalcopryite mineralization occurs in ~~the~~ wide, generally north-south trending shear zone along three creeks, tributaries of the Porcupine River. However, on closer examination it was found that these three generally east-west trending tributary creeks represent separate shear or fault zones and that, therefore, the ore occurs over much narrower widths along these east-west trending shears. I understand that no work is planned this season on this property but that further exploration will be undertaken next year. Average grade of the discovery is approximately 1.5% in copper.
