Subject Frank Mills Prospecting Proposal, Telegraph Creek Date June 16, 1964
Area, British Columbia (10/G)

Frank Mills of 70 Brant Street East, Orillia, came in to present a proposal with respect to the Mess Creek valley area south of Telegraph Creek and northeast of the area being drilled by Kennco. He claims that Kennco will probably develop 150 to 300 million tons of 1½% copper.

Mills claims that the Mess Creek area was staked by Hudson Bay a few years ago but they pulled out without doing much work because of unfavourable provincial legislation at that time involving taxation of ore still in the ground. He claims to know of a few showings in the area and his idea is that he would want to raise sufficient money to stake about 400 to 500 claims on contacts and plugs and then prospect the area this summer and next summer.

I questioned the advisability of staking such a large number of claims on the basis of a few showings and to tie up areas underlain by contacts and plugs. Mills did not seem to have fully considered what he wanted to do and had no concrete ideas about the sort of terms he wanted. I suggested that he could contact us again after he had decided on his terms.
