In the Quesnel Lake area, we have staked the 16-claim Shiko Group. The location of this group is shown on the enclosed aeromagnetic sheet and on the enclosed geologic map. According to Ted Larose who was one of the stakers, there are logging roads on the property which should be passable by landrover at this time of the year.

Rob Thorburn mapped a few outcrops in the course of staking and found that both syenites and diorites occur on Shiko #2 and 4. The rest appeared to be volcanics or overburdened areas.

We would like you and Cap to thoroughly prospect this ground and give us your impressions.

On the Murphy Lake sheet (93-A/3) there are a number of thumb-print anomalies which should be checked. These anomalies are located at 52°04'N, 121°06'W; at 52°02'N, 121°06'W; and a third thumb-print at 52°10'N, 121°03'W. The first two of these anomalies are located approximately three miles east of Murphy Lake and are on the road. The third one may not be accessible, but not all of the roads are shown on the maps we have and perhaps the Mining Recorder or the forestry people could tell you about the roads. Please give me a call when you have done this work or sooner if you happen to come up with something.

Fred will make the landrover available to you and you can use the accompanying credit card for gasoline purchases.
