Re: Possible Au property south of Telkwa, B.C.

On 8 Sept 1982 when I was discussing the Pass Property with Will Tompson he mentioned an old property south of Telkwa.

The property is located across the ridge from the Hunter Basin south of Telkwa. An adit/winze of approximately 100 feet was driven in the '20's or 30's. The adit intersected mineralization in the footwall, a winze was driven then a drift and raise up into the ore which broke into the adit footwall further from the portal.

The mineralization is contained in malachite, tetrahedrite, quartz and electrum. Will reported most of mineralization in the adit has been removed but he found samples with visible electrum and tetrahedrite in quartz. There is apparently a very strong structure visible on a topo map which may host similitan deposits. The alteration zones around the adit are reported to indicate the presence of a favourable structure nearby.

The property is accessible by a rough 4x4 road from Telkwa.

At present W. Tompson and I plan to visit this property on Wednesday September 15, 1982
