Subject COPPER PROPERTY - SMITHERS AREA Date May 2nd, 1961

While talking to Bill McGowan in Smithers last week, he advised me that he had just heard that a major exploration company had staked eight claims on a copper property last Fall. He said that they had discovered a vein of copper 300' in length by 15' in width, averaging 3% Cu. This vein is supposedly faulted at one end and he wondered if we would be interested in staking the adjacent ground.

Again, this property is in helicopter country and the cost of staking might be something in the order of \$500.00.

Mr. McGowan felt that the occurrence had not been adequately covered by staking last Fall, but that it would now, in all probability, be very quickly covered this season.
