Attached is a submission received through my friend Don Worth.

The one geochemically-anomalous area of apparent interest is unfortunately not well protected claims-wise, and also the properties as a whole are badly shaped.

However the one apparently-interesting anomaly is close to the Caribou-Bell property, and because we have a smouldering in that property I think perhaps that you and Fred should plan on a visit to the area, at which time you could look at Mollusca's anomalous locale and perhaps run the EM-16 over it and take a few geochem check samples.

If you think that this would be warranted would you please let me know. I would then ask Don Worth (who is on holidays to July 17th) to tell the Mollusca people that we would like to visit their property, and to ask them for a map showing the position of their geochem samples.
