

The "Wilf" claims have been recorded and await acceptance by the Parks Board. With respect to the staking of these claims, Wilf, it should be understood that they constitute an addition to the "Boom" group, staked at Bill Sirola's request to ensure adequate coverage on the Ramsey property. The request was made because of a geophysical trend in that direction from the Boom Creek showing, hence the Participation Clause in the prospectors agreement would not apply.

The "CC" group of course comes under the prospectors agreement and the participation clause is in effect. I anticipate further work on the "CC" claims next season.

Enclosed is a sketch map showing the claim status as of September 26th, 1967.

As a result of our I.P. work which indicated the highest anomaly to be on Line OO, I felt that we did not have adequate protection to the southeast. I should point out that Line OO is on the south boundary of claims #1, 2, 11, 12, etc. Accordingly, I asked John Lund to have Christian and Cornwell stake 12 claims to the southeast but they ended up staking 18 claims. They did this because they found Copper mineralization in frost heaves on the south side of Ramsey Creek. On September 22nd, I advised Al Groome by radio to square off the block to the northeast and when these 12 claims are staked, we will then have exactly 100 claims in the group.

Christian and Cornwell were the only people available to do this work since the students had all left, but it does not entitle them to an interest in this property. The interest arrangement does not apply because they were assigned to a staking job and not a prospecting effort. They do, however, have their interest in the 6-claim C.C. Group which they staked earlier.
