Insufficient work was done on this group for proper evaluation. There appears to be an 800 gamma magnetic anomaly but there is no outcrop and it is difficult to do a proper geochemical assessment because of the low ground. No future work appears justified at the present time.

SUBJECT: REPORT ON FULTON RIVER GROUP (POI)

SUMMARY:

The Poi Group is situated some three miles southeast of Chapman Lake on the Fulton River (latitude  $54^{\circ} 54'$ , longitude  $126^{\circ} 35'$ ). The group was staked so as to occupy an airborne magnetic anomaly.

E.M. and magcrometer lines were run along the two location lines of the group. No conductors were found.

INTRODUCTION:

E.M. and magcrometer lines were re-run on the Poi Group to determine the presence of mineral conductors. Soils were also taken.

SURVEY RESULTS:

No conductors were found on the lines run. Due to extensive swampy terrain on the group, it was impossible to give the property a complete survey. If the group is to be covered with a complete survey, the work will have to be done when the swamp freezes.

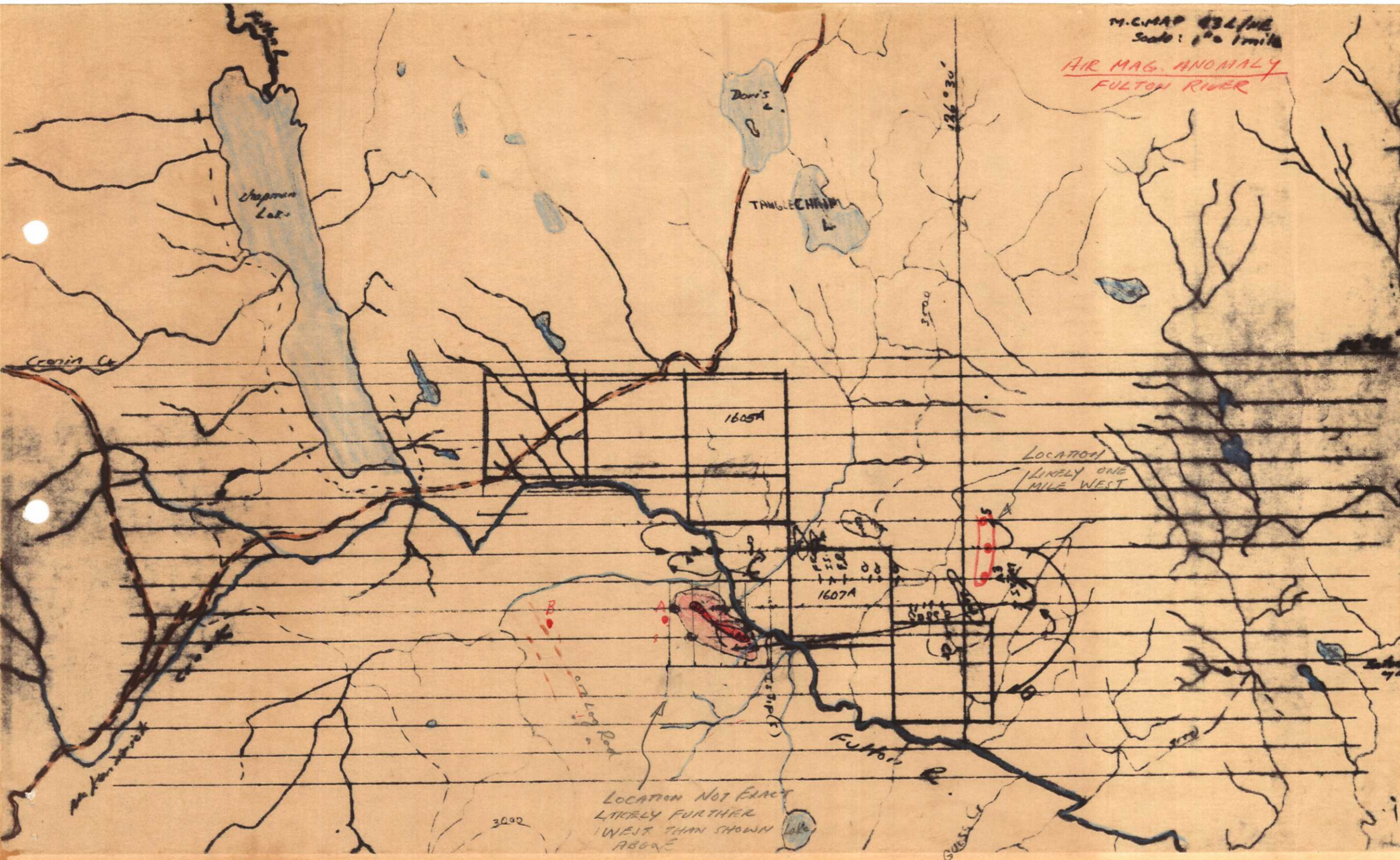
