Upon completion of the Tweedsmuir Project, Christian and Cornwell were assigned to check out two aeromagnetic anomalies in the Babine and Morrison Lake areas and to silt sample the streams north of Morrison Lake. They started their work on September 25th but because of 18 days of continual rain, were forced to terminate on October 25th.

The causes of the magnetic anomalies were found in each case and traces of copper were found in the so called "N" anomaly northeast of Morrison Lake. Soil samples from both have been submitted for assay and the final results will be submitted as all the material is compiled. The stream silt sampling had to be abandoned because all of the creeks had reached flood stage.

Christian and Cornwell commenced their employment on May 25th and accordingly should be paid to October 25th. Each was under a 5-month contract. A termination slip will be submitted for each.

For Gordon Robertson's purposes, Christian owes Kerr Addison \$18.57 and I mention this here only because his final pay cheque might be sent to him before the expense account is processed. *- noted*
