MEMO RE: SPANISH MOUNTAIN SHOWING

QUESNEL MINING DIV., BRITISH COLUMBIA

F. McCallum, 3651 W. 15th Street, Vancouver, British Columbia submitted a Gold property located at Spanish Mountain, B. C. This information came from a B. C. prospector, H. G. Creelman, 2821 Trinity Street, Vancouver, B. C. - Phone HA 2997L.


Creelman reported that two B. C. prospectors were seeking a deal on a property located on Spanish Mountain near Likely B. C. He stated they had a quartz vein 40 feet and traced for 500 feet from which assays up to 2 oz. in gold were obtained. McCallum submitted samples that were said to have come from the vein. No visible gold was present on inspection. The vendors whose names were not disclosed wanted an examination made.

Investigation revealed that the property is reported on in the 1933 report of the Minister of Mines, British Columbia page A134 under the heading of Mariner. This report shows that considerable work had been done on the property at that time and as far as is known nothing of economic importance had been developed. In 1937 more surface work was done by a company called Spanish Mountain Exploration Ltd. (B. C. Mines Report 1957 page 14)

A wire to Creelman (attached) shows that the present owners are working on the same veins discovered in 1933 and that one of the principals is named Tug Wilson of Spanish Maritan Exploration Ltd., Riverside Motel, Princeton, B. C.

McCallum was advised that unless further investigation by him revealed something of new importance we did not wish to make an examination at this time.
