#### PART I - COPPER BELT WASHINGTON

R. J. Nethery reviewed the work carried out during the period from June to September 1974 which consisted mainly of geological reconnaissance and rock geochem sampling.

Some percussion drilling is planned on the block of eleven mineral claims that were staked in August 1974. The drilling is, of course, subject to the approval of the State Conservation Authorities as the claims are located in a heavily forested area.

The work program recommended for 1975 will consist of further mapping and sampling programs within the designated project area (see following resolution) and, should results warrant, the acquisition of title and follow-up drilling.
