TEEPEE PROPERTY - MOYIE

A geologist, Bernard R. Pearson, brought in data on the above property located 3½ miles southeast of Moyie on the gas pipeline.

The showings consist of a number of trenches exposing a number of ferruginous and manganiferous veins trending toward Moyie and traceable for over 1400 feet. The original showings were exposed by trenching during the construction of the gas pipeline. Since then Utah Construction and Mercury Exploration (R. Chaplin) have optioned it and completed further trenching.

No primary sulphides have been identified in the present showings and Pearson is recommending drilling to test the veins at depth.

Apparently data on the property was submitted by a Mr. Pighin in 1969 and is filed under 82-G-4/5 in the N.T.S. file.
