Herewith Fred's report, a plan showing the areas under investigation and copies of the geochemical analyses.

Since our magnetic definition over the Sullivan Mine leaves something to be desired, I will have the Elsec returned to Vancouver and we will check the tuning of the broad band filter and if Duncan Crone left the narrow band filter in the circuit, we will put in a switch which will enable us to select either band. We feel that the narrow band filter may prevent some of the helicopter electrical noise from getting into the magnetometer head, and this should give us much better definition on relatively weak targets such as the Sullivan deposit.
