> With the aim of establishing an order of magnitude for the size of the Silver Zone deposit(s), the following drill program is proposed. Refer to the long section for locations.

Holes P1-P5 will all be in the upper drill area and will enable the south-eastern extent of the deposit to be better established. P6 should be on section 97+00, but due to the unsuccessful attempt to drill RG-76 on that section further ground examination will have to be undertaken.

It is also proposed that the up dip projection of the deposit to surface be explored by trenching. Approximately 6-8 trenches will be required between Lines 100 and 98 or so. It is intended to use the same cat that makes our drill roads so the trenching may start as early as next week.
