This property was the subject of a lengthy treatise in the George Cross News Letter No. 237, dated December 8th. In this news letter, W. J. Weymark mentioned a total ore reserve of more than 47 million tons averaging 0.93% Copper.

The West Coast people have been drilling the former Oro Denoro claims which Noranda had under option somewhere in the mid-1950's. I learned from Tom Elliott that two capable Japanese had recently investigated the ore reserve on the property and they advised Tom that they could only find one million tons of ore on the property. These hearsay comments by the Japanese and by Tom Elliott are not necessarily gospel, but are much more likely to be somewhere near the truth than the picture developed by Weymark. This belief tends to be corroborated by the current market account of the stock which is now selling for something like 70¢ per share.
