I also remember seeing the closed loop on the road on the upper right-hand part of the sheet.

John Lund has done some additional mapping on the Channel property, but I don't have the results of that work as yet.

We will lay out drill holes as soon as I have the results of John's mapping.

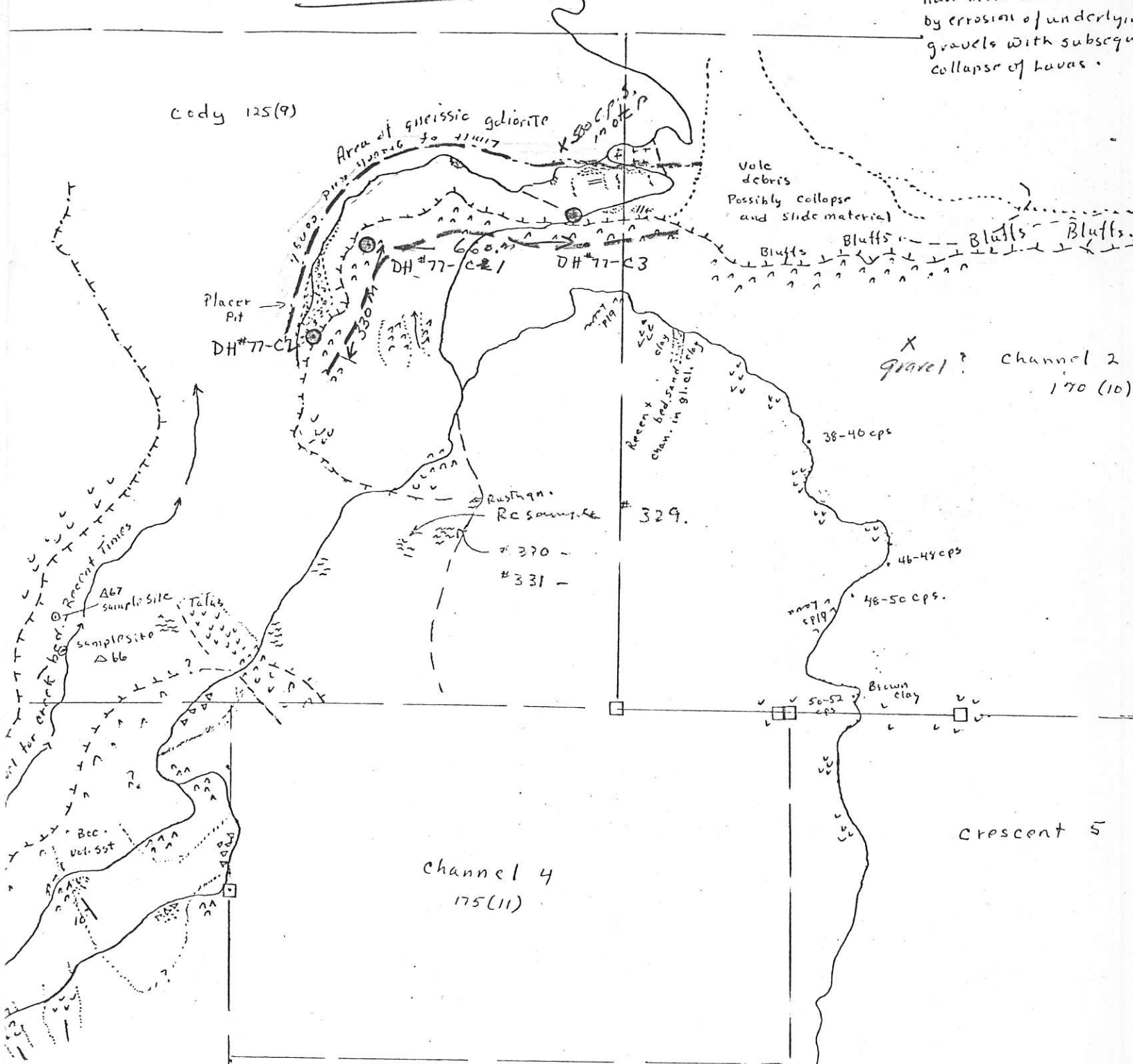
The presence of

Summary

C1 - temporarily abandoned
- basalt too hard for rotary
Will be re drilled with diamond drill, then rotary.

C2 - 0-39 m. Miocene gravels, abundant pyrite
& pink garnet

39-42 m Bio. gneiss
Note: High radioactivity (1500 c.p.m. @ 34.5 m.)
but less than 0.3 m wide.

C3 - 0-60 m clay + gneissic
& Volc. boulders (plastic)
60-63. Foliated gneiss.
No radioactivity.
