Finally, I shall keep an eye on his northern activity

Pielstickers Asbestos- Sawmill Point:

Ted's letter states we are to examine this property at a convenient time which is located on Dease Lake. Understood.

Fennell Option:

Examined the showings this week, part of which, were under some snow, snow which is disappearing rapidly. Mailed a proposed programme of preliminary development to you Thursday. Would like to get this, or any part of this programme approved and started early during the coming week. Will phone you Monday on this. Tell Doug Stewart, will get the documents signed and witnessed on my next visit. My opinion is a programme as outlined would determine the value of this showing. I am puzzled over the lack of copper float on a property with such high copper assays.

Angus Horne lead -zinc-silver information.

This showing is located in the general vicinity of Trophy mtn, B.C. Index area 82 M. Some time ago I examined a complex base metal showing, originally found by the deceased Angus Horne, in the same vicinity. The staker, relative of Horne, told me of the lead-zinc showing and stated he had searched for it and had been unable to find it. At Chu-Chua, Marston Fennell showed me a sample he had secured from what he claims is the Angus Horne prospect. He said he had taken the sample himself, had not staked it, on account of locational inaccessibility, a common practice in the mountains here. Later this year, probably in the fall, we might take a copter in and look at it. Curious how the information dove-tails.

Chateau Mica Claims, Mica Mtn, B.C. Index area 94 C.

Attached is some information on the mica quality on these claims. Is there a market for this material. Location is near the Wenner-Gren development, about which there has been considerable publicity. The property has been known for some time. It has been offered to us by the original finders, on our terms. Asked Ted Macka to return originals to owners.
