In reply to your memo of 4th August on this showing, my understanding is that the so-called "Alco" occurrence is a 20' wide shear zone on the contact of Nelson quartz diorites with volcanic rocks. The shear zone probably averages 0.6-0.8% Cu over 20' and is open to the South.

I have no knowledge of radioactivity over this showing at the moment.

Any similarity between the Brenda deposit and the "Alco" showing must be a figment of someone's imagination. Under the circumstances, I cannot get wildly excited by the adjacent Belcarra ground.
