

I am writing this letter, to see if your Company might be interested in a lead, zinc, property which is 100% owned by myself. The property is known as the CK property. It consists of 305 units, most of which are in good standing for a few years to come.

The property is situated on the Raft River in the Kamloops Mining division, on Map sheet 82MI3E. The property contains Stratiform zinc-lead mineralization and has many showings along its lenth, which is very long, a few miles.

The property was originally found and staked by myself in 1973. The property was first Optioned by Rio Algom in 1973, In 1974 Rio Algom drilled 4 holes on the main boulder showing and the new showing, but failed to intersect any amount of Mineralization in place. These showings at the time looked like they could be large amounts of high grade zinc, lead glacial boulders, these showings were later found to be in place. In 1975 Rio Algom drilled and got some narrow intersections on the North end of the property and then dropped the Option.

In 1976 a small Vancouver Co, Sicintine Mines optioned the property, they did some backhoe trenching but failed to find the Mineralization in place, so dropped the option.

In the fall of 1977 I optioned the property to Cominco who worked on the property in 1978-1979-1980 and just recently dropped the option on the property. Cominco did considerable work on the property, including about fifty drill holes, geochemistry and geophyical surveys. Cominco found zinc lead mineralization in place in the Main Boulder showing, the new showing and the Raft Synform area to the North. The mineralization grades as high as 30% combined zinc, lead in places. The area with the most work done on it by Cominco is the new showing which has fairly consistant mineralization along its lenth of over 6000 ft, and is open down dip. Some grades along strike in the New showing area.

North end 7-8% combined lead zinc, lenth 700 metres, width

2-5meters

Central Zone 6-9% """"""" Lenth I000 meters, width

On the Spring showing at the south end of the property there is a fairly long geochem anomaly which has never been tested with narrow lead zinc showings, in place and massive lead zinc boulders along its lenth. The new showing also the main boulder showing are at low elevations, about 3500 ft elev, and are on a good logging road which follows the Raft River for about 65 KM from Clearwater, BC on highway 5. The North end showings are also on this road but at a higher elevation.

I have complete reports on all work done on this property by Cominco and Rio Algom.

The property should be free off snow in late April, as most of it is in an old burn, and is quite open.

If you are interested in the property I could show you the reports at any time, and the property in the spring.
