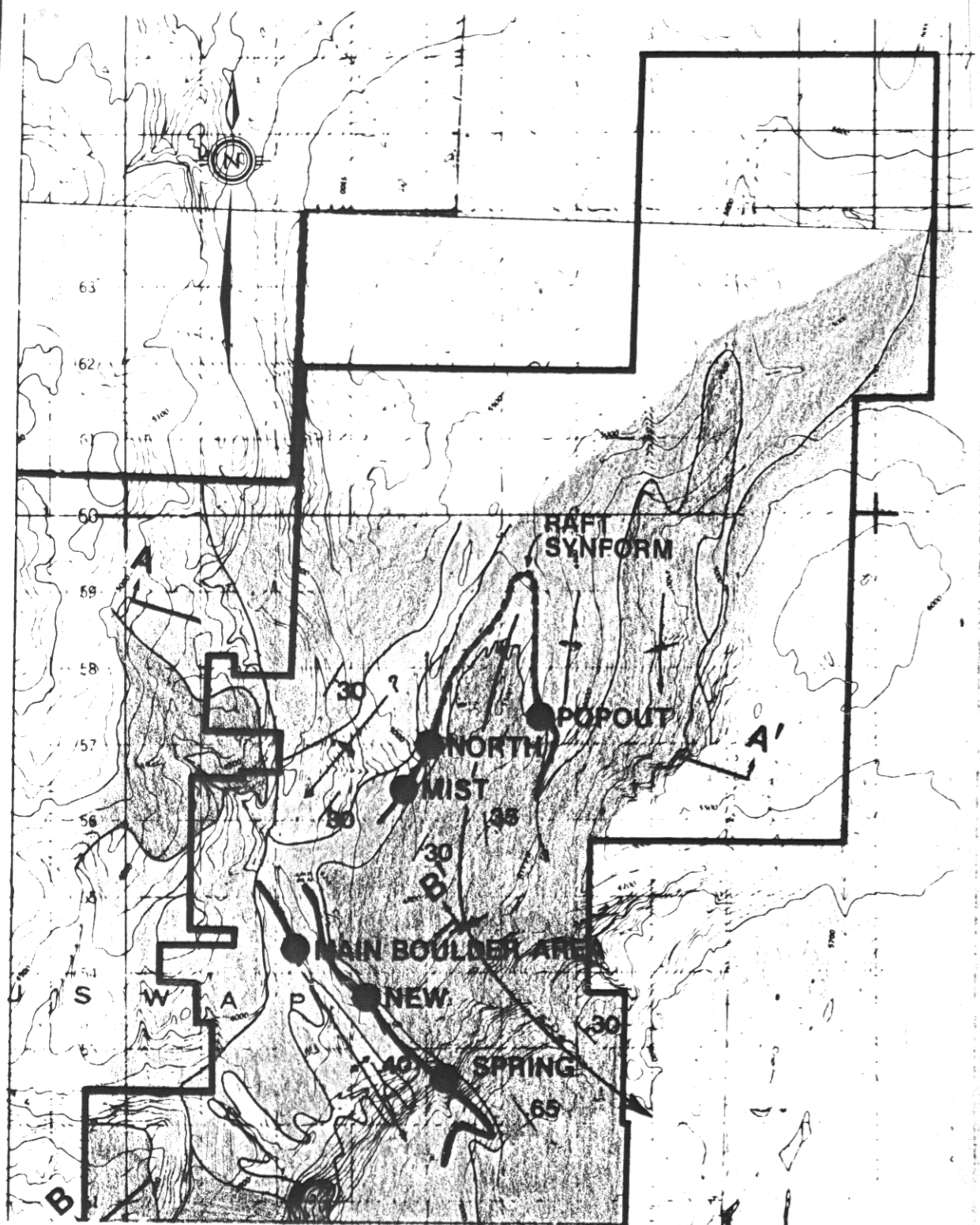

Thank you for bringing this to our attention. I look forward to a visit in April or May.

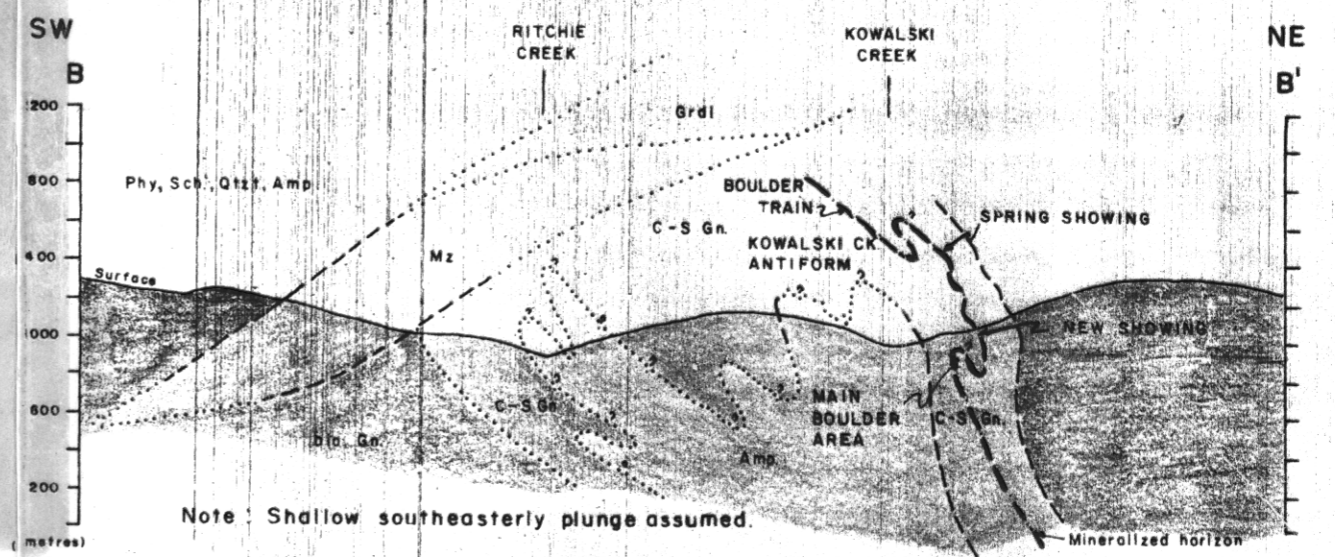
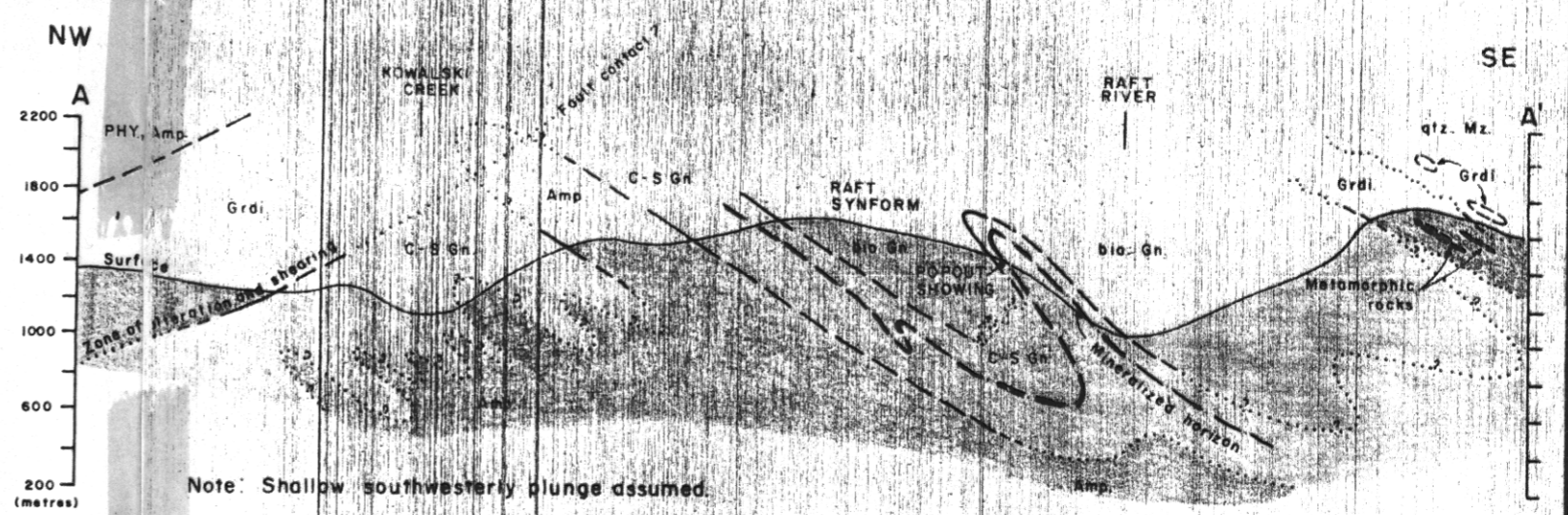

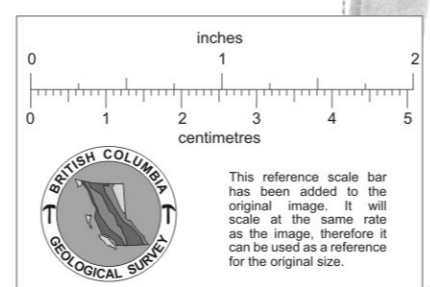
