Enclosed herewith is a print of the Dusty Mac work that has been completed thus far. Indicated on the map are the locations of the first line of drill holes that have been laid out.

Also indicated in red are the samples which have returned assays of 1 oz. of silver or better. One oz. silver without additional credits for gold and silica cannot possibly be ore grade, but in view of the apparent increase in values as the depth of the trenching is increased, the 1 oz. figure is considered as an arbitrary cut-off for present purposes. Within this area we are cleaning out the trenches and washing them down so that very detailed mapping can be accomplished.

The drill and driller had not arrived on the property as of this morning and was therefore contacted by Marcel Guiguet. The report is that driller had had a breakdown of his truck while enroute from Merritt and would not be able to reach the property before Wednesday, September 24th. (The drill is truck mounted). In the meantime, cleaning up of the trenches will be continued and the detailed mapping will be started.
