Enclosed herewith is a duplicate of an assay certificate received today from John O. Dolphin, Osoyoos, B.C..

I called Gus MacDonald and was advised that the samples each represent a width of 10 ft. across the zone at a point approximately 20 ft. north of the collar of the raise. At the time of my visit it appeared that there might be three sub-parallel zones trending slightly east of north through the breccia zone. Some hand trenching was laid out to test this theory and these two samples are from the first of these trenches.

I am sending you these results not because I think they are excessively important but so that you will have the data on hand, as I am quite sure that these results are going to be fairly common knowledge, as both Gus and Joe MacDonald have seen the location from which they were taken.
