A REPORT ON A PROPOSED OPTION OR JOINT VENTURE OF THE
SILVER LICHEN CLAIMS
OF MILLEX RESOURCES LTD.

SUMMARY

The Silver Lichen Claims of Millex Resources Ltd. ("Millex") are situated in a geological environment favorable to base metal and/or precious metal deposits.

The geochemical surveys, geophysical surveys, geological mapping and prospecting completed so far have located two areas that warrant detailed geophysics prior to diamond drilling.

The most recent work in 1988 consisted of deepening an existing trench by blasting. The trench is located immediately south east of a 300 meter long by 50 meter wide geophysical anomaly. A 5 foot chip sample of the bottom of the trench returned the following values:-

47.95 ozs/ton Ag; 17.98% Pb; 5.30% Zn; .010 ozs/ton Au.

The mineralization is disseminated in a limestone sequence which underlies greenstone. The limestone lies on top of phyllite. It is suggested that the downward extension of the limestone has been completely replaced by mineralization where the geophysical anomaly is located.

A similar mineralized outcrop has been located approximately 1350 meters due east of the initial discovery outcrop. Geophysical surveys have confirmed the presence of conductors.

Detailed geophysics should be undertaken to define drill targets. A work program as follows is suggested:-

Millex was formed to own a 50 ton silver-lead-zinc-gold flotation concentrator which was used to process and test mineral from the claims of Killick Gold Company Ltd. Upon completion of pilot mill operations Millex is now arranging to farm out all its claim holdings and to dispose of equipment.






