- his VMS target is an argillite = exhalite - no significant economic sulphides/assays reported in summary
- very little recent work done on claims - mapping 1976, rest of work done in 1920's.
 - looks steep + inaccessible in places.
- host rocks = Unuk R volcanics - much lower in stratigraphy than Eskay Creek.
