Approximately three weeks ago, while we were working on the aeromagnetic release for Vancouver Island, DeRoos submitted an iron property in which we were not interested, but he also mentioned that he and his partners had located a new copper vein 6' wide, 2000' long and assaying 7% copper approximately 10 miles out of Zeballos.

The topography is rugged and DeRoos states that there would be some 1400' of mining height on the vein. We had intended having Alex Burton investigate the vein at the same time as he was looking into some of the aeromagnetic data, but he was advised by DeRoos's partner in Zeballos that the vein would still be snow covered.

DeRoos's partner will advise us as to when snow conditions will permit looking at this situation.
