Thank you very much for your letter of June 8 1989, verifying your expenditures to date on our mineral claim. We are certainly impressed with the amount of work you have done and the accuracy of your system. Hopefully you are getting a good picture of the geological structure which may justify a continuation of your exploration up to a successful mining venture.

Last year one of your geologists took a look at our property on Mt. DeCosmos and we were disappointed that your company did not see fit to undertake an exploratory drilling program in that area.

At the present time, we are embarking on a major program in the Clayoquot Peninsula - Kennedy Lake area as the MacMillan Bloedel road engineers have recently located the adit to old workings which location has been a mystery for over 80 years, on the "Okay" Group of mineral claims. They have shown us exactly where the adit lies and they are installing a road, right to the edge of our Claim #348 (Crown Granted).

This property has copper and zinc values (over 10 %), plus gold and silver on a very distinct contact zone.

Would it be possible for your Exploration Manager to arrange a field trip to check out the values and look at the old workings sometime in August or September, 1990 - with a view to arranging a working contract.

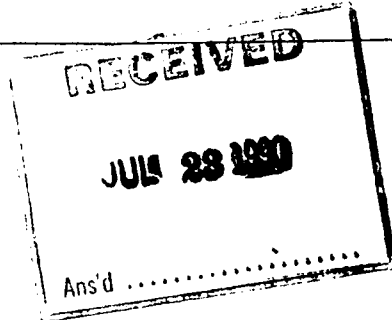
