<u>Owner</u> :	Westpine Metals -34% owned by Westley Mines -34% owned by Alpine Exploration
<u>Claims</u> :	282 units wholly owned 44 units under option from Westmin-Homestake
Location:	225 km north of Vancouver; 270 km by road from Williams Lk.
	30 km south of Fish Lake - all work in valley - thin o/b + trees
<u>Geology</u> :	mineralization hosted in qtz diorite/granodiorite and adjacent altered sediments/volcanics
	alteration = qtz-andalusite - pyrophyllite qtz qtz-magnetite

Mineralization:

- 1. <u>Empress zone</u> 3 zones of mineralization
 - a. 76 Zone
 - b. Lower North
 - c. Upper North

-total reserve estimate: 11.1 m tons @ 0.61% Cu, 0.023 opt Au

-mineralization 450-700 ft - high stripping ratio 5.9:1

2. <u>Buzzer Zone</u> 10,000 ft. east of Empress

-5.5 m tons @ 0.35% Cu, 0.031% Mo

- 3. <u>Rowbottom Zone</u> 7000 ft. south of Empress altered qtz monzonite -drilled by Sumitomo in 1970 -hole S-22: 185 ft. @ 0.41% Cu, 0.034% Mo
- 4. <u>East Zone</u> 4000 ft. east of Empress -hole 91-38: 35 ft. @ 0.26% Cu, 0.017 opt Au -hole 91-39: 47 ft. @ 0.60% Cu, 0.022 opt Au
- 5. <u>Granite Creek</u>

-extension of Lower North zone -hole 91-43: 746-800 ft, 0.21% Cu, 0.014 opt Au/54 ft. -hole 91-49: 611-903 ft, 0.23% Cu, 0.008 opt Au/291 ft.

<u>Conclusions</u>

-extensive low grade Cu-Au mineralization on property

-most of better values at depths > 500 ft. ... high stripping ratio

-to be economic need 100 million tons+ of Empress type grades near surface
