Minister of Mines Report. The report mentions four parallel quartz veins varying in width from 14 inches to 8 feet and dipping at 20 to 25 into the hill. The assays from these veins averaged only \$1.75 per ton at the 1932 gold price and I am afraid this is hardly enough to justify investigation on our part. Unless you have some information to the contrary, then we cannot see any purpose in working on these veins. It is always possible that more information has been developed since 1932 and we would be quite receptive to anything which might indicate that the picture is better than it appears to be in the old literature.
