Attached are copies of data given to me yesterday by (Al) W. E. Simpson, a director of General Resources. The data concern that company's property 4 miles southwest of Craigmont and consisting of a total of 59 claims made up of the Wade, Sarge, and Major claim groups.

He reported that they had Hunting do an I. P. survey over the claims originally, then Asarco did an I. P. survey and concluded that pyritic mineralization was causing anomalies found. Being advised that Asarco's conclusions might not be correct, General Resources have recently had McPhar do an I. P. survey. Simpson did not have McPhar's complete results in hand but did have a preliminary letter from McPhar (copy attached) which includes a recommendation for one drill hole to be drilled. That is where the property sits at the moment.

Simpson claims that General Resources have spent approximately \$50,000 on the property. They apparently would want Kerr to make a firm initial work committment of \$30,000 for which we would receive 200,000 shares of General Resources (15¢ per share equivalent). In the final analysis of any type of deal made, they would want to have 40% of the profit; I left him in no doubt that I considered that a very tough deal.

He said that General Resources is selling for 14-15¢ on the Vancouver listed exchange.

He advised that Ron Stokes is their group's fully employed engineer, and I said that I would ask you to contact him to obtain full particulars. Stokes is in their office at 213 - 678 Howe Street, Vancouver; telephone Mutual 2-2751. Stokes may have McPhar's complete report in hand by the time you contact him.

Please let me know your thoughts on the property after you have contacted Stokes.

Simpson left me a copy of their Second Annual Report which I am keeping here as you will undoubtedly be able to obtain one in Vancouver.

A preliminary study has been made of the L. P. results on parts of claims WADE Nos. 7, 9, and 15. A series of weak to moderate Induced Polarization indications suggests that a zone of anomalous metal factor material extends more or less continuously from 48N to 64N. This zone appears to coincide with an inferred fault at or near the contact of the Nicala Series and the porphyry intrusive.

The Induced Polarization indicates variation in both the intensity and depth of the source. In our opinion, further investigation should be made of these anomalies. The following test drill hole is recommended to test the most favourable results.

Line 60N at 12W; to be drilled east along picket line at -45° to intersect the contact.

A detailed report and discussion of the results will be prepared in the near future,

The terms of the Agreement between General Resources and A. S. & R. for the Wade group, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles southwest of the Craigmont Mine, are covered in the March 22nd George Cross Newsletter.

Briefly, the Agreement gives A. S. & R. an option for $2\frac{1}{2}$ years, during which \$110,000.00' worth of exploration must be carried out if the Agreement is to be maintained in force for the full $2\frac{1}{2}$ year period. A. S. & R. has until September 15th, 1964, in which to place the property into production, but the production date may be increased by 4 years by payment to General Resources of \$100,000.00 per year. A. S. & R. is not entitled to recover the first \$250,000.00 of advances. If the property is placed in production the division of profits would be on the basis of 60% to A. S. & R. and 40% to General Resources.

I send this information to you largely to indicate that the 60% – 40% type of deal is not at all uncommon in British Columbia, even amongst the relatively staid organizations.
